13 CFR § 125.11 provides:

Veteran has the meaning given the term in 38 U.S.C. 101(2).

A Reservist or member of the National Guard called to Federal active duty

or

disabled from a disease

or

injury incurred or aggravated in line of duty or while in training status also qualify as a veteran.

38 U.S.C. § 101(2) provides:

The term "veteran" means a person who served in the active military, naval,
or
air service, and who was discharged or released therefrom under conditions other than dishonorable.
